SAHS is a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, formed in 1979, whose mission is to provide services to pets. St. Augustine Humane Society promotes healthy responsible lifelong pet ownership by serving the medical and rehabilitative needs of companion animals in our community. Our programs are designed to strengthen human-pet relationships and reduce the need for pets to enter shelters. Our goal is to ensure all pets have access to quality veterinary care, prevent overpopulation, and end animal suffering.

Board members have the potential to serve in a number of areas, as well as to carve out new initiatives, based on their interests, availability, and expertise. A term of general service is 3 years. Executive Board members serve for one year or until a successor is elected.

Board members promise:

- to ensure that the organization does the best work possible in pursuit of its goals.
- to assist with the development and growth of the SAHS
- to believe in the purpose and the mission of the organization, and act responsibly and prudently as its steward.
- to represent the organization, and act as a spokesperson.
- to attend at least 75 percent of board meetings, committee meetings, and special events. Board meetings are approximately I to I ½ hours long, and presently are scheduled on the third Thursday of each month.
- to actively participate in one or more fundraising activities.
- to grow member involvement through committees
- to stay informed about what's going on in the organization.
- to participate in and take responsibility for making decisions on issues, policies, and other matters.
- to make a personal financial contribution at a level that is meaningful to the individual. Suggested minimum donation: \$500 per year.
